Children at St. John's will:

- Let people see their good side and not their bad side
- Always speak to everyone with respect
- Let people join in their games, especially those who are on their own
- Share their belongings
- Try not to play with people that make them silly
- Respect each other's space
- Walk away when someone starts a fight
- Only go where they are allowed to go
- Keep the football to the marked pitch at the junior end of the playground
- Take care of the school buildings, grounds and equipment
- Not touch anything that does not concern them

Children at St. John's will never:

- Kick or bite
- Push, smack or punch
- Swear, use bad language or tell lies
- Answer back or be rude
- Swap things

Children at St. John's should not:

'Hit back' either physically or emotionally (by look or comment) and if an incident occurs an adult should be informed
